I Can Talk To God

Monthly Memory Verse:

“The Lord will hear when I call to Him” Psalm 4:3b

Week 1: God Answers Gideon’s Prayers, Judges 6-7

This story helps children understand that Gideon prayed to God, asking Him to give him a physical answer. He wanted to know that God would go with him when he battled the Midianites. Not only did God answer Gideon’s prayers as he had requested, but he went with Gideon, helping him win the battle without even fighting! I can talk to God too when I need His help!



Week 2: A Mother’s Prayer Is Answered, 1 Samuel 1:1-2:10

This week children will learn that Hannah was very sad because she did not have children. She prayed to God, asking that He give her a son. She promised that if God answered her prayer she would give the boy back to Him; she would dedicate him to God’s work. God answered Hannah’s prayer and gave her Samuel, which means “heard by God.” Hannah was quick to thank God for Samuel in a prayer of thanksgiving.

Week 3: The True God Answers Elijah’s Prayer, 1 Kings 17:1, 18:1-46

During this lesson, children will understand that Elijah obeyed God. He warned the king that if the people continued to worship idols that God would not send any rain. Elijah wanted to prove to the king and his people that God was the one true God, not the Baals they worshipped. When the people prayed to their gods nothing happened. When Elijah prayed to God he answered his prayers by sending fire that burned the altar to the ground, even though Elijah had drenched it with water before he prayed. Everyone could see that God was the one true God! Then God sent the rain!



Week 4: Daniel Keeps Praying to God, Daniel 6

This week the children will understand that Daniel knew the importance of talking to God and was not willing to stop even when faced with being thrown in the lion’s den. God doesn’t want other things to keep us from praying either. Because Daniel continued to pray, God closed the lion’s mouth and spared his life. Imagine what our faithful prayers can do!

Prayer is an amazingly powerful form of communication that the Lord has given us. These examples from His word show us just how powerful it can be. Continue to pray for your kids, that they would have a praying heart. “Without prayer, I am living off self power.” ~Jillian
